Dear Members,

**Earlier yesterday, Premier Mark McGowan confirmed the cautious easing of restrictions (26 April 2020 update) that came into effect from midnight last night (26 April 2020).**

The information provided seems to suggest that our club could operate with up to ten (10) people at any one time in an indoor or outdoor space as long as equipment is not shared, social distancing of 1.5m is maintained and the sanitation of common areas and equipment is diligently adhered to.

As the government begins to relax their directives it is important to remember, that these opportunities come with a responsibility to ensure that we as a surf club community adhere to the guidelines to keep our members, families and the wider community safe.

With this at the forefront of our decision making, and based on these new directives, the capacity of our club to adhere to a strict regular sanitation of club facilities, including the change-rooms and gym where equipment is shared and to ensure that all touch points and surfaces are cleaned and sanitized regularly, is a major challenge.

In addition, for our coaches, trainers and assessors to be able to effectively regulate and monitor gathering restrictions and social distancing measures at our club, the Board of Management is making the following recommendations:

1. ***Entry to the club, including change rooms and gym are to remain restricted to authorised personnel who are club management, administration, emergency support personal and office bearers.***
2. ***No socialising or loitering at the club.***

It has never been more important for us all to be vigilant and responsible as we navigate the potential, gradual reopening of our club. Your positive response to restricted club access and social gatherings has been a source of inspiration and pride, and I know this will continue to be the case.

Working together as one and uniting as a club to ensure our responsibility to care for each other and the community must still be our top priority. Our members are the lifeblood of our great club and our decisions will always be made with the interests of participants, families and the broader community foremost in our minds.

We will continue to review this position as further updates from Government and Health Authorities is communicated. I am very hopeful that within the next month we should be able to provide more positive guidelines on the safe operation and opening of our club as restrictions are lessened.

Once again, thank you for your understanding and patience through this time. I encourage you to continue to follow Government and health advice to keep you and your family safe.

I hope you enjoy and create wonderful memories of the very special socially restricted gatherings you will share with family and friends.
